Laptop Rollout Process

A rollout session is mandatory for all students.

The device sessions have been arranged to meet the varying needs of our students and ensure they are successful in accessing school resources before the start of their academic year.

While parent attendance is optional, students are required to attend a full session to receive their device.

New International or Long-Distance Boarders (Grades 9-12)

International or long-distance *boarders* will receive their device during the New Boarder Orientation Program. Details will be sent prior to students' arrival on campus.

Should a student wish to attend a session over the summer, in advance of their orientation, they are welcome to sign up for a session, following the guides below.

New Middle One to Senior Two Students (Grades 7-12)

Rollout sessions will be held on the dates and times outlined below and are one hour in length, starting promptly at 10:00 a.m. or 2:00 p.m. Please note that you need to attend only *one* of the following sessions:

Monday, August 19 to Friday August 23, 2024 Monday, August 26, and Tuesday August 27, 2024

Session 1: from 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. Session 2: from 2:00 - 3:00 p.m. Location: Raymond Massey Reading Room (RMRR)

Please arrive and park in front of the Nicholas Arts Centre, making your way to the library (located just above the Schlesinger Dining Hall).

During the information session students will:

- Have their photo taken
- Receive their device and equipment
- Log into the device for the first time and create their unique password
- Learn the basic care of the device
- Review Appleby's policies and expectations (for the device, network, and applications)

As part of the program, all students are issued equipment, software and specialized courseware designed for Appleby.

How to sign up for a session

Log-on to https://calendly.com/newstudentrollout/2024 to view available sessions.

If you have more than one student attending a session, please book a separate session for each student. Students need only attend one session.

Instructions:

- 1. Select a date/time for your rollout session, pressing confirm when prompted
- 2. Enter the *student* information (First and Last Name and **Student Number**)
- 3. You may enter your cell phone number to sign up for reminders, as an option
- 4. Press Schedule Event when completed
